Colossians 1:15-23

Satan's attack on faith is not just directed at the cross but at your very belief in the existence of a God.

William Provine (1942 – 2015), prominent evolutionary biologist, formerly professor at Cornell University:

“If Darwinism is true, there are five inescapable conclusions:”

- 1) There is no God.
- 2) There is no life after death.
- 3) There is no right and wrong.
- 4) There is no ultimate meaning for life.
- 5) People don't really have a free will.

Paul of Tarsus, prominent Apostle of Jesus Christ:

- 1) There is a God who created all things.
- 2) There is a life after death and Jesus proved it.
- 3) There is a right and wrong and we were in the wrong. Our wrongness had to be paid for by the death of Christ on the cross.
- 4) Our purpose for living is to enjoy a perfect relationship with a perfect, holy God.
- 5) You have the choice to choose life, hope and forgiveness.
