The Exaltation of Christ Philippians 2:5-11

The Gospel Narrative

- Jesus was not a man who became God; He is God who became man.
- He did not come as a privileged or powerful man, but he came as an ordinary and common man.
- Jesus did not use his divine authority to escape the temptations and difficulties of the human experience.

Jesus was both our example and our substitution.

- He was obedient.
- He was obedient all the way to death.
- He was obedient to the substitutionary death on the cross.

What does the exaltation of Jesus mean?

- It means that Jesus is risen from the dead.
- It means that the suffering is past and the glory is ahead.
- It means that now is the time for you to receive him.
