There are two attacks upon the character and work of God.

- First is an attack from the outside brought by unbelievers.

In the Bible, mere intellectual assent is never confused with true, life-changing faith in the resurrection of Jesus.

There are four primary reasons for which God gives his children divine power over the present darkness.

- He gives us the power to be His witnesses.
- He gives us the power to bring Him glory.

There are five reasons why you don't have this power.

- You have never given your life to Christ
- You constantly refuse to love and forgive.
- You have returned to your previous addictions.
- You do not engage in sharing your faith.
- Your life does not bring glory to God.

God wants you to know, have and live in this power that comes directly from Him to you.
