What does God have to say?

Ephesians 2:8
- Jesus said that “whoever believes in Him who sent me has eternal life.”
John 5:24
- Jesus also said that no one is able to take you from Him.
John 10:28-29
- Jesus said He would never forsake you or leave you.
Hebrews 13:5
- Nothing can separate us from the love of Christ.
Romans 8:37-39

- I have always been a Christian.
Ephesians 2:1-3
- I attend church, or I am a deeply spiritual person.
Acts 22:3-5
- I have had a powerful spiritual experience.
Acts 8:9-24

Why do believers think they have lost their salvation?

- Remorse over continual sin.
- Bitterness from prayers that were not answered as we wanted.

Why would Satan be leading you to doubt your salvation?

- He wants you to be locked in the constant paralysis of fear
- He doesn't want you confidently sharing God's salvation with others.
