Takeaways from the story:

- 1. There are times when spiritual leaders must get involved with government in order to impede evil.
- 2. There are two great commitments required in stopping evil and providing spiritual freedom and liberty.
 - Being willing to die to provide liberty.
 - Being willing to live sacrificially to protect liberty.
- 3. Before you can effectively make either of these commitments, you must be the one that breaks the generational sin of your family's thinking and starts living unselfishly.
- 4. One of the best sacrifices you can make to help ensure freedom for the coming generation is to take responsibility for a child who is not your own, and mentor them to know the Lord.
