Review: Jude wants us to defend the faith. vs. 3

- Defending it from attacks from <u>without</u>.
- Defending it from attacks from within.
- 1. The promise of the Lord's return. vs. 14
  - A. His coming is <u>certain</u>.
  - B. His coming is <u>visible</u>. Matthew 24:27-30, Revelation 1:7
  - C. He is not coming <u>alone</u>. Revelation 19:11-16
- 2. The <u>purpose</u> of the Lord's return. vs. 15
  - A. To execute judgment & convict.
    - <u>Judgment</u>—verdict for actions rendered.
    - <u>Convict</u>—to expose and rebuke.
    - 1.) On the <u>ungodly</u>—utter disregard of God.
      - a. Ungodly <u>works</u>
      - b. Ungodly words
- 3. The people to be judged at the Lord's return. vs 16
  - A. Grumblers—such as <u>Israel</u> wandering in the wilderness.
    - 1. Discontent—<u>lack</u> of contentment, dissatisfaction with one's circumstances.
  - B. <u>Malcontents</u>—troublemakers, rebellious.
    - 1. Disobedient—refusing to obey someone in authority.
  - C. <u>Self-willed</u>
    - 1. Determined—having made a firm decision and being resolved not to change it.
  - D. Loud Mouth Boasters
    - 1. Spiritual arrogance
