The Missing Piece: Love who Jesus Loves

The love of Jesus doesn't end at the cross, in most ways the cross is just the beginning point of experiencing God's love.

In explaining the love that Jesus has for the church, the Bible uses several metaphors.

#1: The church is the flock of Christ. John 10:14-18

#2: The church is the bride of Christ . Ephesians 5:22-27

#3: The church is the body of Christ. Ephesians 5:28-30; 1 Corinthians 12:27

"If God so loved us, we ought to love one another." 1 John 4:7-11

It is this love that we have for one another that becomes an attraction to the unbeliever. John 13:34-35
