## A Revolutionary Faith: An Easy Faith in a Hard World Matthew 11:25-30

These lessons on revolutionary faith are sequential.

- It starts with the Word of God.
- It moves to knowing God as Heavenly Father.
- But sadly, that is where many Christians stop.
- They stop short of revolutionary faith.

There are two basic schools of thought in this world.

- Life is a mean, ugly reality only conquered by the toughest.
- Life should be good, but it can be kind of hard sometimes.

Jesus does not ascribe to either of these worldviews.

How do we get to this place of a light and easy life?

The answer is found in the worldview of children.

One view is that Jesus is instructing us to be innocent like children.

The Bible does not speak of the innocence of children, but the sinfulness of children.

Jesus is talking about another aspect of the worldview of children.

Matthew 8:5-13

Once you place yourself under the authority, or Lordship, of Jesus, then you will start to experience the ease of life that revolutionary faith produces.
