

## God has a Message for You: Haggai and Zechariah Part 2

The Cornerstone (Jesus) will come from Judah.

Zechariah 10:4

- Bethlehem is in Judah. This is fulfilled in the birth of Jesus.

God will send His Servant, the Branch, the Cornerstone, the Messiah, the King, Jesus riding on a donkey, on the foal of a donkey.

Zechariah 9:9

- This is fulfilled on Palm Sunday, the week of the crucifixion.

The Lord will be betrayed for 30 pieces of silver and it will be thrown back into the temple. It is used to buy the potter's field.

Zechariah 11:12-13

- This is fulfilled by Judas' actions in Matthew 27:3-8.

All of the disciples will forsake Jesus.

Zechariah 13:7b

- Predicted again by Jesus in Matthew 26:31 and fulfilled in Matthew 26:56.

Israel rejects God in spiritual stubbornness and is scattered among the nations.

Zechariah 7:11-14

- This final rejection is complete with the crucifixion of Christ.
- The scattering takes place in 70 AD after the invasion of Rome.

Israel will be regathered back to the land and to Jerusalem.

Zechariah 8:7-8

- This begins in the Zionist movement of the 1920s and is solidified in the recognition of Israel in 1948.

God declares that Israel will never be completely conquered again and that the nations who come against her will be severely injured.

Zechariah 12:1-3

This is being continually fulfilled before our eyes:

- The Six Day War in 1967.
- Yom Kippur War in 1973.
- The present war with Hamas and Hezbollah.

One of the wars that Israel fights will be a war with at least three entities attacking Israel, an entity based in Damascus and Syria, another based in Lebanon, and a third in Gaza.

Zechariah 9:1-8

- This appears to be the war which began on October 7, 2023.

Just because God will save a remnant of Israel (1/3) doesn't mean He won't bring His judgement on Israel when 2/3 of Israel's population dies in the Tribulation.

Zechariah 13:8

The people of Israel will see that Jesus is the Messiah and that they "pierced" Him. They will turn to Christ in repentance and faith.

Zechariah 12:1-11; 13:1

There will be a final battle fought against Israel—the Battle of Armageddon. The Lord, Himself, shall fight that battle for Israel.

Zechariah 14:1-3

Jesus will return with the saints.

Zechariah 14:5

When Jesus returns there will be an earthquake that divides Mount Zion. A fountain will come forth that will feed two rivers, one flowing east and one flowing west.

Zechariah 14:4, 8

Yahweh, and Yahweh alone, will be King over all the earth forevermore.

Zechariah 14:9

How are we to respond to God's prophecies?

- We are to obey the Lord.  
Haggai 1:12a
- We are to fear the Lord.  
Haggai 1:12b
- We are to "be strong" in the Lord.  
Haggai 2:4a
- We are to work for the Lord.  
Haggai 2:4b
- We are to trust in the Lord.
