- 4) Yet in spite of our selfishness and sinfulness, God laid on Jesus the iniquity of us all. Isaiah 53: 6b, 10b, 11b, 12b
- 5) His sacrifice didn't just pay for your sins, but it brought you into right relationship with the Father.

- 6) He did all this willingly, even when he had the power to stop it. Isaiah 53:7
- 7) Even in the darkness of this passage, we see the inkling of light and resurrection. Isaiah 53:10, 12a
