## A Redeeming Faith in a Grieving World

Godly grief doesn't end in loss, it actually leads to repentance and salvation . . . but worldly grief produces even more loss and ends in death. 2 Corinthians 7:9b-10 (PJP)

## What is grief?

Grief is a spiritual response to the experience of loss, often accompanied by emotional and physical symptoms, as well.

The Response of Naomi: How grief is <u>weaponized</u> by the evil one to attack the soul. Ruth 1:13, 20-21

- Satan uses the emotion of <u>bitterness</u> to attack the soul.
- Satan uses the act of <u>isolation</u> to prevent the healing.
- Satan uses the thought of <u>"God's rejection"</u> to thwart the truth.
- Satan uses the emotional, physical, and mental to try to defeat the <u>spiritual</u>.

## The Response of Ruth: How redeeming faith changes the <u>outcome</u> of grief.

- Invest in the ones that you <u>haven't lost</u>. Ruth 1:16a
- Trust in the <u>character</u> of God even when you don't understand your circumstances. Ruth 1:16b
- Live your life with <u>righteousness</u> and integrity. Ruth 3:10
- Be certain that God <u>redeems</u> what is lost and provides purpose, love, and meaning to life. Ruth 4:13-17
