

Experiencing the Power of the Holy Spirit, Part 6
The Outpouring of the Holy Spirit
Joel 2:28-32; Acts 2:14-21

Chapter 2 of Joel is clearly an end-times prophecy.

- “The Day of the Lord” refers to the coming of the Lord.
- The “season” he speaks of is a once in history kind of thing.
- This prophecy corresponds with Jesus’ prophecy in Matthew 24.
- “Afterwards” is a word that means “at the tail-end.”

Peter claims Joel 2 is the explanation of the Holy Spirit’s work on the Day of Pentecost in Acts 2.

There are other outpourings of the Holy Spirit recorded in history which match these Scriptures.

But we can glean from the Bible that there is still one primary period of time prophesied by Joel that is yet to be fulfilled.

Joel 2 and Acts 2 together lay out the blueprint of how we can be part of the fulfillment of this incredible prophecy.

- We function with the absolute assurance of the truth of the Word of God.
- We seek God with sincere repentance and passionate prayer.
- We recognize that the purpose of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit is for the salvation of the lost.
