Jesus on Generosity
Luke 6:27-49

It was because of His radical teaching on generosity that the Pharisee asked Jesus the question, “Who is my neighbor?”

In his famous response, Jesus identifies three worldviews:

- What’s yours is mine and I’m going to take it.
- What’s mine is mine and I’m going to keep it.
- What’s mine is yours and I’m going to give it.

Jesus’ teaching on generosity begins with love and mercy.

There is a difference between living a self-protective life and a life that seeks to protect the rights of others.

Godly generosity is not based upon reciprocal treatment.

Those who reject the logic of generosity refuse to see the spiritual dynamic at work.

The one who is not generous can never denounce generosity until he has tried it because it is not an academic study—it is an experiential reality.
