Lesson #3: God's Love Supersedes Man's Logic

The word of the cross is foolishness to the world.

1 Corinthians 1:18a

To those of us being saved by it (God's love) it is the power of God.

1 Corinthians 1:18b

No one becomes a Christian through the reasoning process alone.

1 Corinthians 1:21a

It is God's plan to use something that the world views as foolish to save those who would choose to believe.

1 Corinthians 1:21b

Mystics seek signs and intellectuals want wisdom.

1 Corinthians 1:22

So, the simplicity of God's love is too ridiculous for them.

1 Corinthians 1:23

But for those of us who have Christ, we have the power of God and the wisdom of God.

1 Corinthians 1:24

God chooses what seems foolish (but actually is not) so that no one could say that they were saved by their own intelligence. No one can boast.

1 Corinthians 1:29

Every believer becomes a living proof of the wisdom of God.

1 Corinthians 1:30

All true believers boast about what Jesus alone has done.

1 Corinthians 1:31

So our faith rests not on the conclusions of worldly logic, but on the Spirit and the power of God.

1 Corinthians 2:5

Unbelievers cannot follow spiritual reasoning, so you cannot just debate people to Jesus. We must love people to Jesus.

1 Corinthians 2:14

If you love God, you won't believe what God has prepared for you!

1 Corinthians 2:9
