Truth #2: God Actually Has a Plan for You to Follow

Here is how it works. If you immerse yourself into His plan for your life, you will experience incredible freedom. If you don't, you won't!

First, we must receive the only One who can set us free.

Romans 8:1

Second, we must establish freedom from what?

Romans 8:2, 19-21

- Free from the guilt and shame of sin.
- Free from the entrapments of sin.
- Free from the effects of sin.
- Free from the penalty of sin.

Third, we have to acknowledge that many Christians who have been set free return to the prison of sin.

Galatians 5:1, 13a

- I am forgiven, so a little sin won't hurt me.

Fourth, we have to realize that not only are we set free from something—we are set free to something.

- I forget that the plan is to experience the love of God and that freedom is the by-product of the love.

Galatians 5:6, 13b

Last, how can I live in the love and freedom that God intended for me?

- I remember that Jesus did for me what I could not do.

- I remember that wanting sin becomes a mindset that ends in...
 - Death Romans 8:6
 - Hostility to God. Romans 8:7
 - An inability to please God. Romans 8:8
