Philippians 2:25-30

Our Bible study so far:

- Light and darkness are opposite paths.
- It is disobedience that disconnects us from God’s power.
- Embracing the will and the work of God is like “Hitting the Switch.”

We are to shine like lights in the world, but wisdom demands we use different kinds of lights for different relational needs.

The Apostle Paul mentions 5 different ways in which we can effectively shine our lights into the lives of others.

The Light of Family – We are family and we stick together no matter what happens.

The Light of Synergy – We know how to roll up our sleeves. We know we can accomplish more working together than alone.

The Light of Soldiering – There are times when we need to fight, and we are unafraid to do so.

The Light of the Messenger – We are the conduits of truth and we have a message of love, hope, and freedom.

The Light of the Minister – We are caregivers and shepherds for those who are in despair and have been damaged by the effects of sin.
