Ephesians 2:1-8; 1:6-8; 3:14-17

How does God describe His grace for us?

- Grace is the conduit by which we become the recipients of His mercy and love.
- Grace is how we are saved.
- Grace is how we, who were dead, are made alive.
- Grace brings about our adoption, redemption and forgiveness.
- The grace of God that is lavished upon us is immeasurable and incomprehensible in spiritual richness.

The grace of God is such that it demands a response. 3:14-17a

- Grace is not compatible with the philosophies of the world.
- Grace is, by its nature, exclusive—God will not share your affections with anything else.
- Those who would receive grace do so by receiving Jesus and forsaking all else, clinging only unto Him.
