Generosity: A Spiritual Battleground  
2 Corinthians 10:1-6

There are three accusations that always appear in times of generosity:

- Those receiving the generosity are not worthy.
- Those giving generously are doing it for the wrong reasons.
- Those administering the generosity are mismanaging it.

Paul is being accused of these and other things, including, "He's not really an Apostle."  
2 Corinthians 8:1-2, 9, 20; 2 Corinthians 9:7, 11, 13, 15

Many people claim spiritual maturity, even ascend to leadership, but are actually resistant to the teachings of Christ concerning their own generosity.

A life disobedient to the Lordship of Christ eventually becomes spiritually powerless.

Satan often uses our disobedience to generosity as an inroad to disconnecting you from the power of God.

How can we win the battle over selfishness and keep the attitude of generosity?

- It starts with the meekness and gentleness of Christ.
- We walk in the flesh, but we are not of the flesh.
- Only true spirituality and faith have the divine power to break addictive strongholds in our lives.
- Spiritual generosity destroys earthly arguments no matter how lofty the argument seems to be.
- The key is to make each thought subject to Christ and turn our actions from disobedience to obedience.
