Walking in Grace
Ephesians 4:1

Satan attacks God's grace.

Satan seeks to nullify grace.

Galatians 2:20 – 3:6

- If salvation can be achieved by goodness, then Jesus died for no reason.
- If salvation starts with grace but is kept by my goodness, then at some point it stops depending upon grace.
- If good works are ever added to grace, then grace stops being grace.
Romans 11:6

Satan seeks to cheapen grace.

Romans 5:20 - 6:7, 12-14

- If the purpose of grace is to eradicate sin from my life, then continuing in sin subverts God's purpose.
- If the purpose of grace is to set me free from sin, then choosing sin keeps me enslaved.
- If the purpose of grace is to set me free from the law and death, then returning to sin returns me to a life without grace.
