What are the lessons of Revolutionary Faith that we have looked at so far?

- It starts with the Word of God.
- It moves to knowing God as Heavenly Father.
- It acknowledges Jesus' authority as Lord.
- It loves Jesus above all others.

After this, many of his disciples turned back and no longer walked with him. John 6:66

Revolutionary faith believes in Jesus for God's glory. not for personal gain. John 6:22-34

What aspects of your beliefs may be indicators that you have a self-serving, superficial faith?

- You are not very concerned with your sinfulness.
- Your prayers are mostly about your wants.
- You think faith is the path to getting more.
- Failure and pain are considered faith failures.
- The goal is your happiness, not God's glory.

Faulty Faith is me oriented—Revolutionary Faith is all about Jesus!

The Lord's Supper is a time for us to stop and evaluate our faith. Has my faith turned into a "me-first" type of idolatry?
