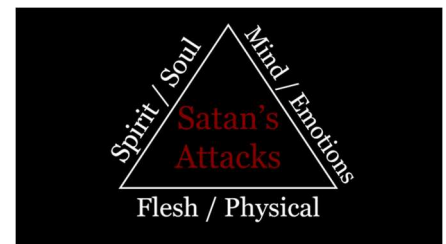
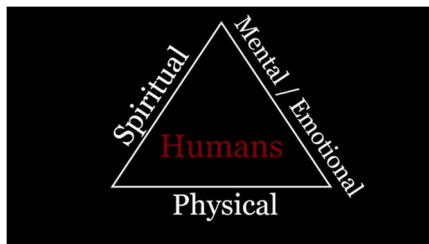
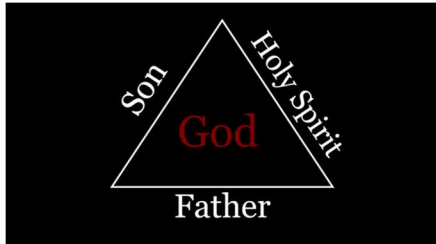


Galatians

Blowing up the lies that blow apart your life: Lie #4

“Satan just hates you in general—he doesn’t have a specific, detailed, organized strategy to destroy you.”
Galatians 3:1; Ephesians 4:14; 6:10-12; 2 Thessalonians 2:9-10a



1) The schemes of Satan that are physical in nature. He will tempt you with . . .

1 John 2:16

- The craving for physical pleasure.
- The longing to have whatever we want.
- The desire to be entitled, applauded and lauded.
- . . . taking pride in achieving these things.

2) The schemes of Satan that are mental/emotional in nature. God created you to know:

- Belonging
- Worth
- Fulfillment

Satan works to take those away, and then blames God that you don’t have them.

Once you have made yourself the victim, his work is easier because you start living life based in your emotions. His emotional schemes are. . .

- Anger because you experience aloneness instead of belonging.
- Guilt because you feel worthless instead of valued.
- Fear because you live in emptiness instead of fulfillment.

3) The schemes of Satan that are spiritual in nature. He will tempt you to . . .

- Suppress the truth of God.
Romans 1:18
- Refuse the love of God.
Romans 1:21
- Exchange the glory of God.
Romans 1:22

He wants to do this to you, then he wants to do it in you, and last he wants to do this through you to tempt and destroy another person.
